Requirements:

In the context of the growing development of renewable energies at sea, a large number of different data on migratory and resting birds, as well as marine mammals, are collected in order to be able to make a sound nature conservation assessment of potential impacts and thus ensure the most nature-friendly development possible. The field of activity in this context includes:

- Cooperation in national and international projects on the topics of resting and migratory birds

- (Statistical) evaluation and presentation of ornithological data (e.g. density calculations of resting birds, application of collision models, evaluation of data from transmitted birds, etc.).
- Preparation of reports and technical expertises as well as support in the preparation of environmental planning documents (e.g. EIA, species protection reports, FFH assessment studies...) in German and English
- Communication with clients and authorities as well as presentation of work results
